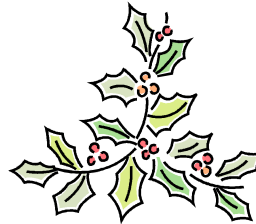

From all the purchases made from Hopwells by CCS this year we have identified those products that contained pork and can confirm that none of the products contained Irish Pork.

Until the FSA advises that Irish Pork can safely be eaten all products with Irish Pork will not be delivered to your establishments

In summary the pork and pork products used by Cambridgeshire Catering and Cleaning Services contain no Irish Pork.
